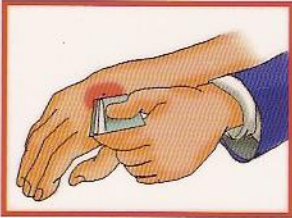


Sudden Illness **ABC** **A**-Airway, **B**-Breathing, **C**-Circulation



Poisoning

- 1) Call **911**, then call poison control **1-800-222-1222** with as much information about the victim and the poison as possible.
- 2) Do not induce vomiting unless instructed by poison control.



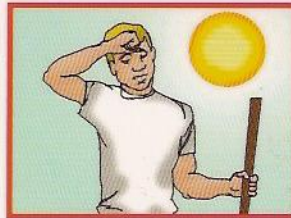
Bee Sting

- 1) Remove stinger using a credit card or other stiff object to scrape the stung area (Do not use tweezers)
- 2) If allergic reaction is suspected, call **911** and keep the airway open, and monitor the victims **ABC**'s.



Cold Related Illness

- 1) Get the victim out of the cold environment
- 2) Change any wet clothing with dry.
- 3) Slowly heat up the victim.



Heat Related Illness

- 1) Get the victim away from the heat source.
- 2) Slowly cool the victim.
- 3) Offer water only if the victim is conscious.



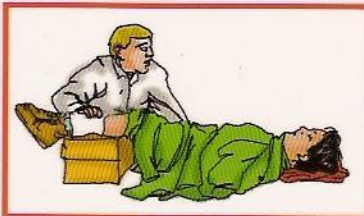
Dental Emergencies

- 1) Put the tooth in milk or water and get the victim to a **dentist**.



Allergic Reaction

- 1) **Symptoms** – Trouble breathing, swelling, turning red, rash, losing consciousness.
- 2) **Treatment** – Call **911** and monitor the victims **ABC**'s.



Loss of Consciousness (i.e. fainting)

- 1) Position the victim on their back with feet elevated 10-12 inches.
- 2) If the victim vomits, turn them on their side and clean out the airway.
- 3) Call **911**.
- 4) Monitor the victims **ABC**'s.



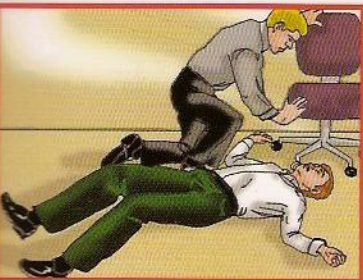
Shock

- 1) **Cause** – the circulatory system failing to deliver enough blood to the body.
- 2) **Symptoms**- rapid/weak pulse, irritability, confusion, restlessness, altered level of consciousness
- 3) **Treatment** – Try to calm/reassure the victim. Monitor **ABC**'s and call **911**.



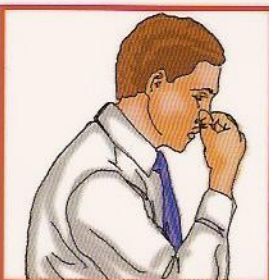
Eye Injuries

- 1) Bandage around any object sticking out.
- 2) Cover the injured eye to prevent the victim from needlessly moving it.
- 3) Call **911**



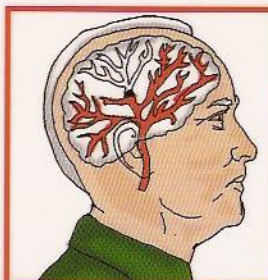
Seizures/Convulsions

- 1) Clear away all objects that may cause injuries.
- 2) Cushion the head.
- 3) Do not attempt to restrain the victim or stick anything in the victim's mouth.
- 4) Call **911**.
- 5) Monitor the victims **ABC**'s.



Nose Bleed

- 1) Do not tilt the head back.
- 2) Pinch the bridge of the nose and tilt the head forward to prevent the victim from swallowing the blood.



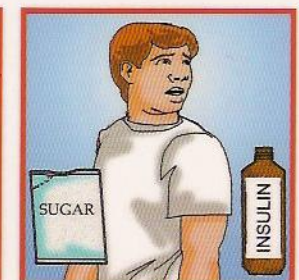
Stroke

- 1) **Symptoms** – Slurred speech, numbness or paralysis to one side of the body, loss of vision, severe headache.
- 2) **Treatment** – Call **911** (the faster you call **911** the better chance the person has of regaining lost motor functions.



Head and Neck injuries

- 1) Attempt to keep the victim from moving.
- 2) If the victim is not breathing open airway using jaw thrust and began **ABC**'s.
- 3) Call **911**.



Diabetes

- 1) Do not give insulin.
- 2) If the victim is conscious give them some form of sugar-preferably some type of fruit juice.
- 3) Call **911**.
- 4) Monitor the victims **ABC**'s.
